**Review of the Progress of Work of Golden Jubilee Event:**

2. A detailed discussion was held on the formation of the Committees (as dished out in the 10<sup>th</sup> EC Meeting) and their work progress.

### **3. Decisions:**

**a. All concerned committee members were requested to update the MECA President about their work progress by 30<sup>th</sup> August.**


